Each city and county across Kentucky has the opportunity to make itself known as the safest place on earth for women and girls by organizing events for a two-week festival to take place August 18 through September 1, 2007.

Kentucky has been chosen as 1 of 2 places in the world to pilot the Festival in 2007.

This historic Festival was held for the first time in June 2006 in New York City and was conceived by author and award winning playwright, Eve Ensler. Ensler is the founder of V-DAY, a non-profit organization committed to ending violence against women and girls around the world. V-DAY is also one of the fastest growing non-profit organizations world-wide.

WHY KENTUCKY?

Kentucky has a rich history of working to end violence against women and is a trailblazer for addressing the issue systemically.

It is for this reason that the global organization, V-DAY, chose Kentucky as a pilot state.

Kentucky will be a model for future Festivals including three that will take place in Paris, France; Denver, Colorado; and Providence, Rhode Island, in 2008.

FACTS

UTVS: KENTUCKY

In Kentucky, a woman is beaten every 9 seconds.

1 in 3 women will be a victim of sexual assault, rape, domestic violence and/or stalking in her lifetime.

Violence against women is not only costly for the victims, but also costs employers 4.1 billion in health care expenses each year.

At least 29,000 acts of rape and sexual assault occur in the workplace each year.

Women who have been raped or sexually assaulted report diminished work functioning, sometimes for up to eight months after the attack.

In 2002, 66% of corporate leaders identified domestic violence as a major social issue.

WHAT WILL YOU DO?

V-Day was born in 1998 as an outgrowth of **Eve Ensler's** Obie-Award winning play, "The Vagina Monologues." As Eve performed the piece in small towns and large cities all around the world, she saw and heard first hand the destructive personal, social, political and economic consequences violence against women has for many nations.

Hundreds of women told her their stories of rape, incest, domestic battery and genital mutilation. It was clear that something widespread and dramatic needed to be done to stop the violence. A group of women in New York joined Eve and founded V-Day . . . a catalyst, a movement, a performance.

V-Day's mission is simple. It demands that the violence must end. It proclaims Valentine's Day as V-Day until the violence stops. When all women live in safety, no longer fearing violence or the threat of violence, then V-Day will be known as **Victory Over Violence Day.**

V-DAY is an organized response against violence toward women. V-DAY is a vision: We see a world where women live safely and freely. V-DAY is a demand: Rape, incest, battery, genital mutilation and sexual slavery must end now. V-DAY is a spirit: We believe women should spend their lives creating and thriving rather than surviving or recovering from terrible atrocities. V-DAY is a catalyst: By raising money and consciousness, it will unify and strengthen existing anti-violence efforts. Triggering far-reaching awareness, it will lay the groundwork for new educational, protective, and legislative endeavors throughout the world. V-DAY is a process: We will work as long as it takes. We will not stop until the violence stops. V-DAY is a day. We proclaim Valentine's Day as V-Day, to celebrate women and end the violence. V-DAY is a fierce, wild, unstoppable movement and community. **Join us!**

FESTIVAL BEGINNINGS

UNTIL THE VIOLENCE STOPS: NYC, which took place June 12-27, 2006 in New York City, successfully took over the five boroughs and made New Yorkers stand up and join V-Day in making New York City the safest place on earth for women and girls.

During the two-week Festival of theater, spoken word, performance and community events, UNTIL THE VIOLENCE STOPS: NYC:

- raised 1.1 million dollars;
- sold-out 4 Events reaching 4,250 people;
- welcomed 2,000 runners in Prospect Park running to demand an end to violence;
- witnessed 50 actresses and over 100 writers contributing their genius, time and talent;
- joined 70 community events in all five boroughs reaching thousands of people;
- held a Press Conference with Mayor Bloomberg;
- placed 2,000 messaging posters on buses and subways in all five boroughs; and
- Made millions of media impressions from editorial coverage in outlets including: The New York Times, The Amsterdam News, Time Out NY, Metro, New York Daily News, Access Hollywood, Al Jazeera, Good Day NY, Queens Times, The Brooklyn Eagle, Womens Enews, and many more.

UNTIL THE VIOLENCE STOPS: KENTUCKY EVENT SCHEDULE

UNTIL THE VIOLENCE STOPS: KENTUCKY will feature marquee events with performances by celebrated actors and original works by noted authors; community events throughout the Bluegrass; a statewide messaging campaign; a parade through Lexington; a workshop for men and boys; and more.

UNTIL THE VIOLENCE STOPS: KENTUCKY will take over the state, putting women and girls, their empowerment and safety directly on center stage. The Festival issues a call to action to all Kentuckians, and to the world: Demand an end to violence against women and girls and become an active partner in ending it.

MARQUEE EVENTS

A Memory, A Monologue, A Rant and A Prayer **Lexington, KY**

This production features monologues addressing violence against women and girls written by world renowned authors: Maya Angelou, Howard Zinn, Kimberly Crenshaw, Alice Walker and several others. Eighty percent of this show will come from works of these authors twenty percent will come from monologues written by Kentuckians.

Anyone of Us: Words From Prison* **Lexington, KY**

This production reveals the connection between women in prison and the violence that often puts them there. It brings forth the raw voices of fierceness and honesty written by women from prisons from across the nation.

***Formerly Incarcerated Women's Discussion Panel** **Lexington, KY**

This panel will be conducted in conjunction with the production described above. Women who were formerly incarcerated in Kentucky's prison population will give insight into their experiences. This panel will present the opportunity for formerly incarcerated women and the community at large to open a dialogue to explore how we can work together to keep victims from being re-victimized through the prison system.

UTVS Gypsy Slam **Lexington, KY**

This event features the best local and national female slam poets. Female slam poets will compete for monetary prizes. Their focus will be violence against women and female empowerment. There will also be appearances by national slam champions.



Necessary Targets* **Lexington, KY**

This production is a ground-breaking play about women and war—about the violence of dark memories and the enduring resilience of the human spirit. This play has been read by Meryl Streep, Angelica Houston, and Calista Flockhart and was performed in Sarajevo by Glenn Close and Marissa Tomei.

***Women in Conflict Zones Panel** **Lexington, KY**

This panel will be conducted in conjunction with the production discussed above. Women who have lived in war zones will share their experiences and discuss the role that female leadership has played in their lives.

COMMUNITY EVENTS

In Our Own Voices Lexington, KY

This is a University of Kentucky student production. All of the monologues in this play have been written by UK students. Each monologue focuses on violence against women and is a true story detailing the experiences of each writer. This play will be cast, produced, and directed by UK Women's Place.

UTVS Parade Lexington, KY

This parade will recognize the contributions of women and girls throughout Kentucky. We hope to include female percussionists from high school and college bands from across the state. We will also encourage the participation of sororities, women's service organizations, social clubs, female politicians, authors, artists, activists, and civic leaders. The parade through downtown Lexington will kick off the two-week Festival.

UTVS Film Festival Lexington, KY

This film Festival will feature a full day of short films by female filmmakers. Both local and national female filmmakers will be invited to Lexington to showcase their work. The festival also hopes to attract female filmmakers from across Kentucky. Filmmakers will compete for a monetary prize and the opportunity to be featured at the festival. Eve Ensler's film, "Until the Violence Stops" will also be screened.

V-Day Latina Lexington, KY

This event will bring the Latina community together to share information about violence against women. We will also welcome the Mexican Consulate to the safest state on earth for women and girls.

UTVS Cycling Event Lexington, KY

Women and men will come together to cycle and bring awareness to ending violence against women.

UTVS Writing Collective Kentucky

This writing collective will focus on essays written by middle and high school students addressing the issue of violence against women and girls and what it means to be a girl in Kentucky. It will be open to middle and high school students across the state. There will be a luncheon to honor 10 featured submissions from each group. We will also feature a female author from Kentucky who will read from her work.



COMMUNITY EVENTS (cont'd)

UTVS Statewide Tree Planting Ceremonies Kentucky

Simultaneous tree planting ceremonies will be held across the state to honor women and girls who have been taken from our Commonwealth as a result of violence. Trees planted by elementary students will also signify hope for the future of women and girls in Kentucky.

UTVS Pieces of Me: Featuring KY Female Artists* Lexington, KY

UTVS: Pieces of Me is a photography project that explores the art of surviving and thriving. Using disposable cameras, female survivors of violence will capture their experiences and, through a series of photography workshops, reveal pieces for exhibition.

****Lexington Clothesline Project* Lexington, KY**

In conjunction with UTVS: Pieces of Me, the Clothesline Project is a collective visual display of t-shirts that have been decorated by survivors of violence or those wishing to honor victims of violence. The purpose of The Clothesline Project is to raise awareness about violence against women and provide another avenue for survivors to courageously break the silence that often surrounds their experiences.

UTVS Golf Tournament Lexington, KY

This golf tournament will be an opportunity for father/daughter, uncle/niece, and/or brother/sister teams to compete in order to raise awareness about violence against women. It will represent the unity needed in order to end this violence.

UTVS Men's Event Louisville and Lexington, KY

We will convene a group of male community leaders and activists to create a one-day workshop that explores men's relationships to violence against women and girls.

UTVS Fashion Show Lexington, KY

We will work in partnership with members of the community to create a fashion expo that will promote a positive body image for women and girls.

UTVS Finale Blow-Out Celebration Lexington, KY

A celebration to conclude the two-week Festival that will focus on moving forward as a state that is now safer for women and girls.

UTVS Red Tent Lexington, KY

The Red Tent is truly at the heart of the Festival and will serve as the resource station for all events happening in the Lexington area and across the state. The Red Tent will be a constant fixture throughout the two week Festival, located in downtown Lexington. It will feature booths from local service providers and Festival sponsors, merchandise for the Festival, descriptions of and maps to Festival events, and serve as a safe place for Festival participants to congregate, meditate, contemplate, celebrate and relax.

PAST SUCCESS

This Festival is founded upon the core belief that education, inspiration, thought, and action can have a far reaching social and cultural impact. UTVS: KENTUCKY will extend the agenda started by UTVS: NYC by presenting a two-week Festival filled with creative events to increase awareness, raise money, and revitalize the spirit of anti-violence against women.

The success of UTVS: NYC was due to the overwhelming support by national, regional and local contributors. Through the monetary sponsorships, in-kind services, and volunteerism the UTVS: NYC Festival was able to touch the lives of 8 million people.

82% of Festival attendees stated that being a part of the event made them want to take action to reduce violence against women and girls, according to a Rockefeller Foundation report.
